TINY TREASURE POTS FULHAM PALACE GARDENS

You can collect a few treasures each visit and make a small “Treasure Pot” together, seeing what you discovered that day.

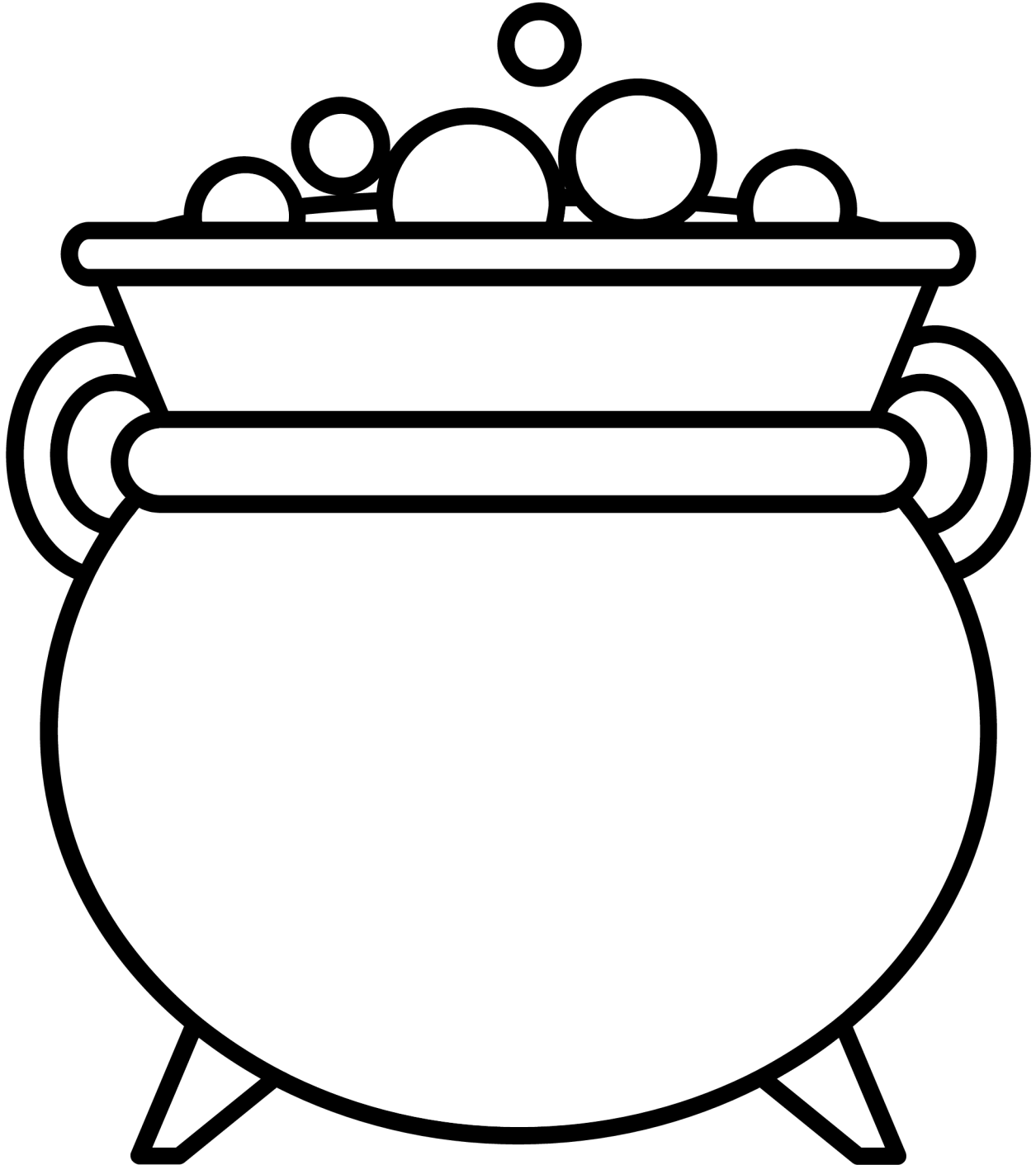
Fulham Palace Gardens are full of petals, leaves, and textures, perfect for little explorers to discover and enjoy!
